



I have nearly completed my first week and a half as Parish Life Coordinator of St. Andrew Catholic Community and nearing 8 years of being assigned to the parish. Although, there have been many changes in this time there has also been some amazing consistencies, such as the joyful feeling I get every morning entering the driveway of the parish. It's beautiful and welcoming just like the people who worship here and find God's healing power in this place. The commitment of the many parishioners engaged in the ministries of the parish is unwavering. However, many are getting up there in years and have earned a break, while a number of our younger people have gone off to college or moved to new places. Therefore, we need more workers in the vineyard giving their time, talent and treasure.

Just as last Sunday, Jesus compares the kingdom of heaven to real life situations. But whereas, the parables from last Sunday talked about things growing on their own, today's Gospel talks about people discovering precious things and giving up anything to obtain them. The evangelist includes three more parables where Jesus tries to help the disciples understand the kingdom of heaven: the hidden treasure, the merchant in search of fine pearls, and the net that caught fish of every kind. Each of the objects, the thing found or caught, is something of great value. Although, Jesus is referring to the Kingdom of God I'm referring to our Parish and what a great value it has for each of us who loves it. My new ministry reminds me of a tribal chief whom I met in the African country of Zambia. When we met, he was wearing boots, jeans, flannel shirt and a toboggan hat. Not what one would expect a chief who sat on a throne to be wearing. He begged pardon for his appearance and humbly stated, I'm sorry for my clothes, however, we are in the middle of remodeling the palace, and sometimes I'm the mason and painter while other times I must be the carpenter and plumber. He was a jack of all trades, and as it is being a Parish Life Coordinator I must wear many hats and use many different skills. There are many skills I haven't mastered and may never; therefore, we need to share our skills together to tend to the vineyard. I will be seeking you out.
