Co-workers in the Vineyard

We are all co-workers in the Vineyard sharing in making St. Andrew the wonderful community it is. We are beginning to see the fruits of getting more folks involved in the life of the parish. For instance, our request for 10 people to pledge \$40 towards the purchase of Albs and Cinctures for young Altar servers was met with overwhelming enthusiasm. We only needed 10 however we received 38 which is nearly 4 times the number. We could divide the cost between the 38 or we can accept \$40 from each pledge and use the funds specifically for liturgical items such as, a large Corpus Crucifix for the sanctuary. If you have any objections please let me know.

Also, you may have noticed the very beautiful Hymnal Boards to display the hymn numbers for the Mass. These were designed and built by one of our parishioners who has requested to remain anonymous. The same parishioner has also repaired the small corpus crucifix and it's stand so it doesn't lean, and is in the process of building a pulley system to easily change the large banner in the sanctuary. While another parishioner has painted curbs and pulled dead trees for us. There are a number teams that keep our sanctuary, assembly area and Chapel clean and beautiful.

We have committee and event setup opportunities, church cleaning and grounds keeping that need to be done on a regular basis. Let Kevin know how you can assist. There are plenty of opportunities to use your talents in the Vineyard of God's Kingdom. Check with the office to explore where you might be of assistance. As portrayed in the Gospel it's never too late to work in the Vineyard including our parish community.
