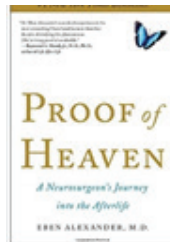

Vocations

The Holy Father said 2018 is a special year for vocations to the priesthood and religious life, because the Synod of Bishops will reflect on young people, especially “the relationship between young people, faith, and vocation”.

Pope Francis reminded Christians that God never ceases to call men and women to follow Him. “We are not victims of chance or swept up in a series of unconnected events; on the contrary, our life and our presence in this world are the fruit of a divine vocation,” he said.

He said the mystery of the Incarnation shows that God constantly “comes to encounter us,” even in troubled times.

To listen to that voice, to discern our personal mission in the Church and the world, and at last to live it in the today that God gives us:

These lie at the heart of Pope Francis’ message for the 55th recurrence of the Day of Prayer for Vocations to be commemorated on April 22nd.
