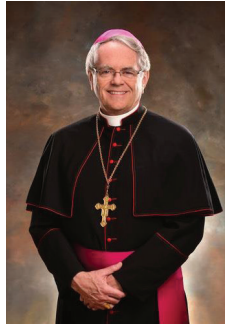

Parking Lot - SPECIAL Collection

On May 27, 2018, our parish of St. Andrew will again be taking up our monthly SPECIAL Collection for repaving our parking lot. Our fund started with a goal of \$200,000. We currently have received \$24,316.70 which is up \$2,501.70 from last month. Thanks so much for your generosity and support of this project.

Repaving the asphalt in our parking lot is a significant project which as a general rule should be done every 10 years or so. Through our preventative maintenance, we have been able to extend the life of our current surface for over 20 years. We know that is it time to consider repaving.
