Why did Jesus teach in parables?

Parables are a style of storytelling that are drawn from everyday life and are used to illustrate or compare ideas with heavenly or divine truths.

The question is why Jesus would let most people wonder about the meaning of His parables. One instance of this is in Jesus' telling the parables of the seeds in the gospel reading (June 17th). Before he interpreted the parables, he drew His disciples away from the crowd and explained the full meaning. Because the disciples accepted truth from Jesus, they were given more and more truth. His parables contain great volumes of truth in very few words to those with a genuine hunger for God. So, then, a parable is a blessing to those with eyes open to the light of truth, willing ears to hear, and understanding hearts.

Read/re-read the parables of the growing seed and the mustard seed (Mark 4: 26-34). What messages does Jesus convey to you? Blessings --
