And, as my brothers, the United States Bishops, have reminded us, all are called to be vigilant, precisely as good citizens, to preserve and defend that freedom from every thing that would threaten or compromise it." - Pope Francis*

Catholics across the United States are encouraged to **pray**, **ReFlect**, and **Act** in support of religious liberty at home and abroad during *Serving Others in God's Love: Religious Freedom Week* which began on June 22, the Feast of Sts. Thomas More and John Fisher, and will end on June 29, 2018 the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul.

The chairman of the USCCB's Committee for Religious Liberty, Archbishop Joseph E. Kurtz of Louisville, states: "Religious freedom allows the space for people of faith to serve others in God's love in ministries like education, adoption and foster care, health care, and migration and refugee services. We encourage people of faith to reflect on the importance of religious freedom so that we might have the space to carry out our mission of service and mercy, and we invite everyone to pray for our brothers and sisters who face intense persecution in other parts of the world."

**Be a Witness of Charity**

The Peter's Pence Collection (PPC) has ancient roots, linking back to New Testament times when people would provide material support to those preaching the Gospel for distribution to those in need (see Acts 4:34-35, 11:29). This collection is the way we, as members of the Catholic Church, unite ourselves to the concerns of the Holy Father. Donations to this collection support the charitable works of Pope Francis for the relief of those most in need.

**How Pope Francis Invites Us to Make the World Less Cold and More Just**

Pope Francis has encouraged us not to "fall into indifference, but become instruments of God's mercy." Each of us has been called to be an instrument of God's mercy and to be a witness of charity. For "it is precisely in the measure to which we open ourselves to others that life becomes fruitful, society regains peace and people recover their full dignity."

**How We Can Join Pope Francis and Be a Witness of Charity**

Your generosity is a witness to charity and helps the Holy See reach out compassionately to those who are marginalized. For example, with support to the PPC a funding network has been created to respond to the needs of Immaculate Conception Parish school in Al Huson, about 12 miles from the border with Syria. With the arrival of many refugees from the war in Syria, these children not in the school system are learning to read and write.
