**Deacon Tim's Corner**

The people in this week's gospel of Mark are quarreling about who has and who hasn't washed his hands for dinner. This was "a tradition of the elders" to preserve physical health (as we do, of course.) But, Jesus tells "these defenders of religious tradition" that they don't pass on what Moses gave them, God's goodness and love. "This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me." Jesus calls them "hypocrites" because they "abandon the commandment of God and hold to human tradition."

The disciples don't get it; so Jesus provides further explanation. Jesus shows that the heart affects the whole person. "For it is from within, from the heart, that evil intentions come." What they must understand is that it is not what you take into yourself that renders you impure, but rather "the things that come out are what defile" (Mark 7:15). Whatever you practice, Jesus is saying, whichever traditions you do or don't uphold, these are not the things that, by themselves, get you ready for God's kingdom. And, you must be ready now. Are you?

In recent days, I have been encouraged by the leadership of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops for formulating policies and processes to hold bishops “to the highest standards of transparency and accountability.”

These goals, according to Conference President Cardinal DiNardo, “will be pursued

leadership by the laity.” The proposed policy will ultimately require the approval of Pope Francis.

While these revelations are tragic and distressing, they also provide an opportunity to further purify and strengthen the Church, heal its gaping wounds, create new accountability, bring an end to secrecy and concealment, and further protect the precious children and youth of our community.

Finally, it is important that we do not permit these crises to overshadow the Church’s
