This collection also helps offset the cost of tuition, housing and the education of our seminarians.

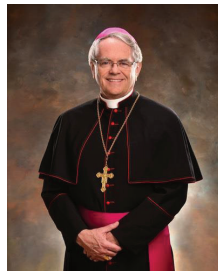
promote works of charity.
