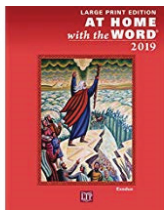


## St. Andrew & Beyond...

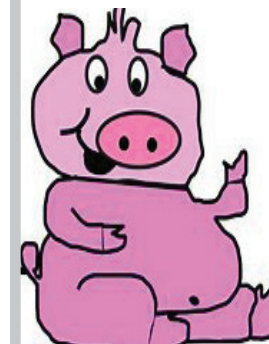
