## Synod of Bishops

Pope Francis' choice for the **2018 Synod of Bishops**, held from October 3rd through October 28, 2018: "Youth, Faith and Vocational Discernment."

### What is a synod?

*Literally speaking the word "synod" means a "coming together." The Synod can be defined as an assembly of bishops representing the Catholic episcopate, having the task of helping the Pope in the governing of the universal Church by rendering their counsel. The Synod of Bishops was established by Pope Paul VI, 15 September 1965.*

### "Youth" Synod Highlights

Young people from around the world told Pope Francis and members of the Synod of Bishops that they no longer want to remain on the sidelines but want to take an active role in the church. *The term "young people," as defined by the Synod, are those ages 16 to 29, which includes youth (adolescents) and young adults.*

"The church needs to create similar spaces where young people can voice their opinions, their hopes, their needs and their struggles, without being judged," said

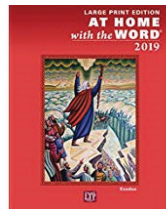
Sebastian Duhao, a member of the youth council in the Diocese of Paramatta, Australia, "The church, like I had to, must learn to use its ears, to listen to the world around it, to listen to what is required of it and, most importantly, to listen to the voices of young people because we have something to offer."

Mariano Garcia, national coordinator of youth ministry in Argentina, said the church needs to take greater care of young people, especially the poorest or "the 'nobodies' of the society in which we live, young people who are cast aside, the ones who nobody cares about."

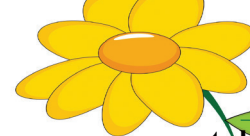
